All volunteers must be fingerprinted through the Diocese of Orlando and complete the Safe Environment Training. To schedule a time to be fingerprinted at one of the Diocesan fingerprinting sites, go to our website at [www.allsoulscatholicschool.org](http://www.allsoulscatholicschool.org), and click on the tab Parents/Alumni and scroll down to "Fingerprinting/Safe Environment Training." Fingerprints will not be cleared until the Safe Environment Training has been completed.

**These are Diocesan policies that govern all individuals that volunteer in any capacity at the school. This includes all field trips, classroom parties, fundraisers, driving students to any athletic event and any volunteering on campus. Fingerprints must be *CLEARED* before any volunteering can be done.**
