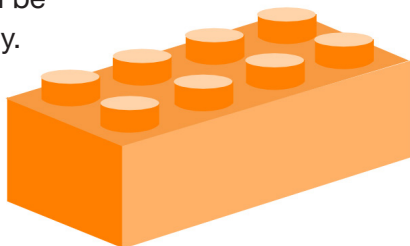
## Bricks 4 Kidz
